

A CAMPUS DESIGNED FOR BELONGING

Nestled on nearly three acres in Oakland's vibrant Rockridge neighborhood, the East Bay Jewish Community Campus is a dynamic destination where community, culture, and connection thrive.

- Main Building: A 3-story central structure features a striking Jerusalem stone lobby. This 58,000-square-foot building houses offices for a broad array of Jewish organizations, co-working lounges, meeting rooms, a café, adult education classrooms, a library, and a six-classroom preschool with garden-integrated learning for up to 120 children.
- Event Center: Over 15,000 square feet of flexible space includes a large performance hall, four versatile event spaces, a kosher kitchen, and multiple conference rooms and offices. This premier venue hosts a vibrant mix of arts, culture, education, wellness programming, holiday celebrations, and year-round community gatherings.
- Creative Space Buildings: Five additional buildings support community-based organizations, as well as youth and creative programming. Highlights include a teen center, makerspaces, artist studios, and areas for young adult learning and community building.
- **Central Courtyard and Grounds:** The heart of the campus features beautifully landscaped grounds—including the *Shivat Ha'Minim*, the seven biblical species native to the Land of Israel—alongside a playground, athletic court, learning garden, meditative spaces, and outdoor stages.
